

## Hidden Harbour Lake Association Meeting

April 26, 2018

In attendance: Jan Siotkowski, Jim Nally, Steve Roberts, Joey Apgar, Michel Soubeyrand, Larry Goodheart, Jim Norton.

### 1. Condition of the Lake.

- There has been reporting of dead Gizzard Shad in the lake. This often occurs when the lake gets as cold as it has been this spring. We will be asking Aqua Doc to help with the fish cleanup.
- There is concern that there are too few weeds in the lake at present to provide sufficient coverage for the fish. We will be advising AquaDoc to use less herbicide this year by providing specific areas in the lake to treat.
- It has become apparent that there is erosion at the south beach. There was discussion regarding solutions.
- Other areas that were discussed included treating an area where milfoil has been found and the problem of fishhooks.

### 2. Budget.

- Michel went over the budget with the main point being that \$6420.00 was invested in 2017 for water quality and fishery analyses.
- With the extra money we've spent on water quality work, our cash balance has dropped below the target of \$30,000. We'll need to revisit our cash balance when we develop next year's budget.

### 3. Goose Control.

- Sixty eggs have been destroyed so far this year. The bird control people will be making two more visits.

### 4. Discussion of Committee Members.

- Joey and Larry are up for election this year.
- A member of the community will be appointed this year to take the place of Steve Roberts who is stepping down.
